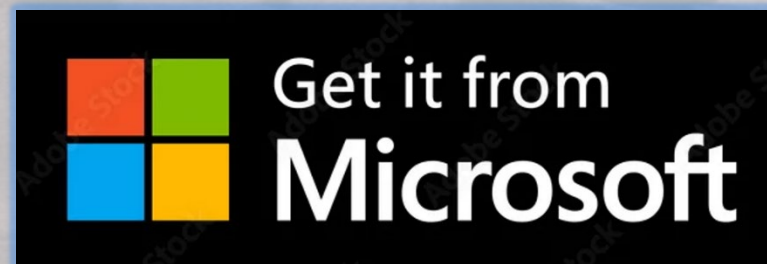
# Survey 123 Form

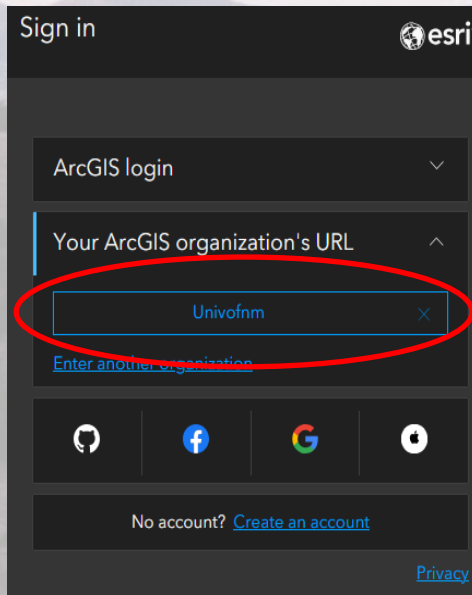
- Step 1 → Download Survey123 from your App Store

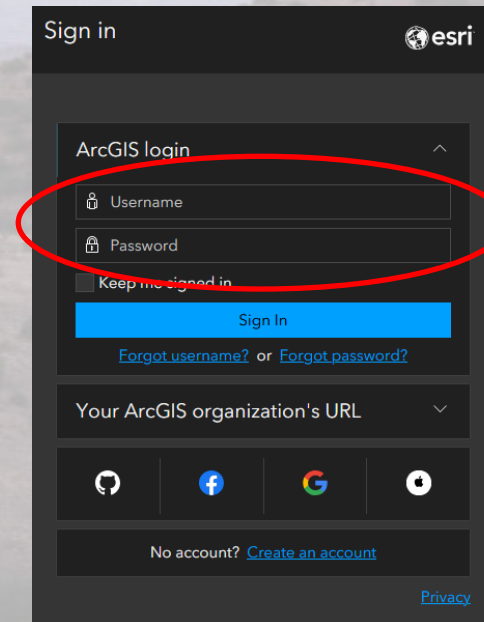
- Step 2 → Login to Survey123 App
