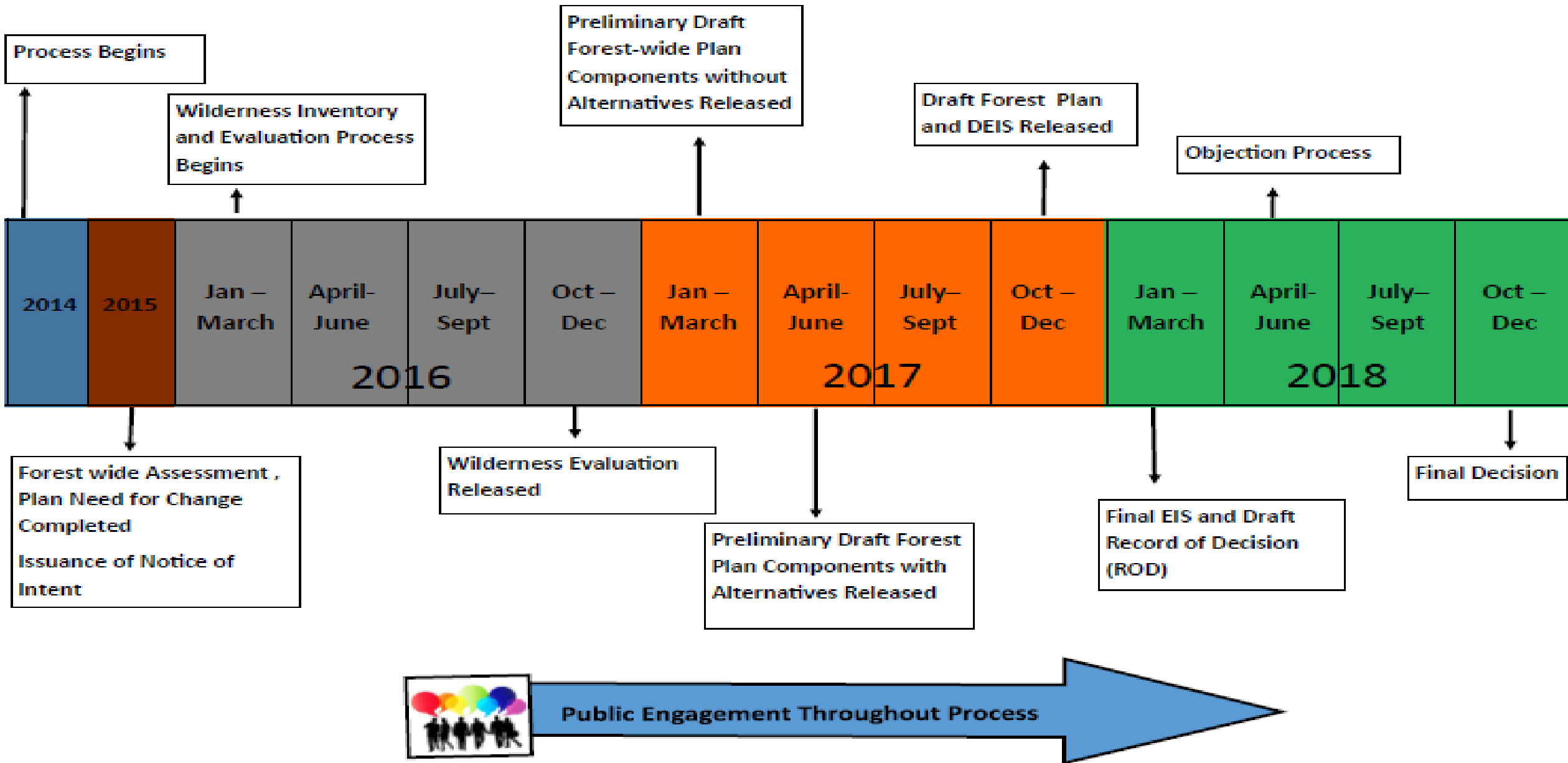




Carson National Forest Forest Plan Revision
